This is to insure that your group receives their minutes in a timely fashion. *Please also review the contact list and make changes accordingly.* If you are a new Subcommittee Chair please be sure to update the contact sheet as well. Note: Area Minutes are also available for download on the Tampa Funcoast website. For all members of the ASC who give reports that are included in the ASC monthly minutes, I am requesting that you submit these reports typed. GSR/Alt GSR **must** fill out a meeting schedule change form so that it can be updated on the meeting schedules and on our website. If you have a Motion Request form to turn in, it must be turned in before we discuss today's New Business or you will have to wait until the next ASC meeting for the new motion to be read on the floor.

\$222.54 was spent on printing Area Minutes, Literature Order Forms, GSR Reports, Meeting Change Request

Forms, Motion Forms, New GSR Packets and corrected meeting schedules as well as office supplies.

At today's GSR Orientation there was no in attendance. Please be sure to announce the GSR Orientation to all your groups.

According to page 1 of our Policy (under *Removal From the Meeting Schedule*), "If there has not been a representative of the Group present for four (4) consecutive ASCs, a Group will be removed from the Tampa Funcoast Meeting Schedule. While a Group is not required to be a voting member of ASC to be placed on the Tampa Funcoast Meeting Schedule, a group representative must attend two consecutive ASC meetings", i.e., must be present for ASC roll call. This ensures that meetings that no longer exist are not placed on the schedule. Therefore, the following groups have been removed from the meeting schedule, attendance and the mailing of minutes due to four (4) or more absences: Per Policy (under Reinstated to the Meeting Schedule), "If a Group has been removed from the Tampa Funcoast Meeting Schedule, it may be placed back on the list by sending a representative to ASC. At ASC, they should notify the Public Relations and Helpline Chairperson that they would like to be added to the next publication of the schedule."

Please discuss the CAR report and Literature Survey and VOTE before the MARCH ASC. You do NOT have to wait for your HG meeting to learn about the CAR. Encourage your HG members to go online and look at these motions before your HG meeting. IT IS IMPORTANT TO READ THE SUPPORTING INFORMATION! SOME MOTIONS "LOOK GOOD" AT FACE VALUE, BUT HAVE NEGATIVE CONSEQUENCES THAT YOU MAY NOT HAVE THOUGHT OF. As you discuss the motions, remember this is a GLOBAL fellowship. There are many addicts who do not read in English or have immediate access to computers and internet. Some HGs hold special CAR voting sessions separate from their monthly HG meeting. HGs must be registered with World Services in order to vote and may only vote once. I have a list of registered groups that I will provide to be posted on the website. Some groups are listed multiple times, some I did not see. Please check to be sure your group is registered.

Note - Motion #2 has 3 parts. It is possible that it will be broken into 3 different motions. Please provide input on EACH of the 3 parts as well as one overall vote for the motion as written.

There are two ways to vote:

1. The Region will establish a link for on-line voting from March 7 - March 26 @ 2pm.

 Your HG can complete the tally sheet and survey that I handed out. I will post them to the minutes as well. These must be brought to me at the March ASC as I will be taking your votes to the March RSC.
 All addicts can go to the NAWS website and vote individually on the Literature Survey ONLY

The CAR is too big for us to publish with the minutes. You can access it at <u>www.na.org/conference</u>. There are 14 Motions and a 2-page Literature Survey to collect information about how the fellowship feels about future needs for recovery literature. I will not spend ASC time discussing each of these on the floor, a CAR Workshop was held January 23rd. However I am available at the break or after ASC (as I am moving tables) to answer any questions.

Florida Region's donation to NAWS in September was \$6,943.17 and in November was \$8000 for a total of \$14,943.17.

Can be downloaded from the WSC site or you can order it from na.org to be sent in print (approx. \$11). Contains the NAWS Strategic Plan, budget, and project plans, including who can be seated at WSC. This is the information that could become part of the *next* CAR. Workshops will begin in February. Available dates: Feb. 6, 13, 20, 27, March 5, 12, 26 (GSR Assembly). I have not asked to host a workshop as the GSR Assembly will be here in Tampa.

PR Pamphlet being worked on and draft will be available for 90-day review by fellowship in the near future. World Convention in Brazil lost money due to low attendance, but had a positive impact on the growth of the fellowship in Brazil.

2016 WSC in Woodlands Hills, CA April 24 - 31.

Fellowship contributions exceeded \$1 Million for the first time in the fiscal year 2014 - 2015. Though a large amount, only a small part of the \$16 M annual budget.

There are several FREE publications on na.org to which all addicts can subscribe to stay informed. These include NAWS News, NA Way and others.

The positions of Regional PR Resource Coordinator, Alt Treasurer, and Archivist are open. See the website for qualifications and responsibilities. PLEASE, PLEASE ask those in your HG to consider one of these positions.

Several Workgroups still need staffing are listed in Regional Business. If you want to be a part of any of these, fill out the volunteer form on the Regional Website [http://naflorida.org/service-list/]. Be sure to include your non-NA skills as well as they may indicate your expertise in areas that may be important. You can click on the workgroup you wish to be involved with. WORKGROUP MEMBERS ARE REIMBURSED FOR MILEAGE COSTS TO RSC.

Region is creating a SPECIAL volunteer form specific to the next World Convention in 2018. Several *thousand* volunteers are needed. This should be available soon. Volunteers must be registered for the convention.

FRCNA: Rosen Shingle Creek in Orlando July 6 - 10. Planning meetings are the first Sunday of even numbered months. Pre-convention shirts and registration flyers are out. I have brought flyers with me. Already 167 registrations, 147 banquets have been sold of the planned 350, so if you are interested in going to the banquet, be sure to buy your ticket or table soon. The FRC BOD is willing to lend their experience to local convention committees if needed.

There are several Regional Proposals listed under Regional Business. I will need your vote at the March ASC to take to the March RSC.

The next Regional Weekend will be at the GSR Assembly at the Tampa Sheridan, 10221 Princess Palm Ave., Tampa, 33610 on March 25 - 27, which happens to be Easter weekend. As this is local, the Area will not pay for hotel rooms. While the Region will provide rooms for GSRs, we have allowed them to use our rooms for out of town GSRs. It is customary that the host area arrange for an activity to host the RSC participants on the Saturday Night of RSC. I have coordinated with the Convention Committee and they will host the event.

May RSC will also be here at the Tampa Sheridan, so there will be no Area hotel rooms provided. The Saturday night of this RSC will be a FRCNA fundraiser event, but we may be asked to host a meeting at the hotel on Friday night. More will be revealed.

There is an issue with my attendance at the March ASC: I am asking you to bring me important information in March, but I have a prior commitment to attend a Recovery related event in March each year, and it falls on the same weekend. Since our RCM 2 recently resigned, I do not have an alternate. My plan is to ask you to pass on all papers you will bring to my HG GSR to give to me at my HG and to make myself available by conference call to answer any questions. As there will not be an RSC before our March ASC, I will not have any new information to give you.
