Hi, my name is Anna and I'm an addict. On the table to my left is the sign-in sheet, announcement sheet and contact list. If your group has elected a new GSR or if you did not receive your minutes this month please update the contact list. Please indicate whether you want your minutes **MAILED, EMAILED or NOT Mailed** in the far right column of the contact sheet. This is to insure that your group receives their minutes in a timely fashion. If you are a new Subcommittee Chair please be sure to update the contact sheet as well.

Also, located on the table to my left, there are event flyers, literature order forms, GSR report forms, and meeting schedule change forms. There is a box on the table for the GSR reports to be submitted. All meeting changes such as time or location can be put in the GSR report box as well. However, you also **must** fill out a

meeting schedule change form so that it can be updated on the meeting schedules and on our website. If you have a Motion Request form to turn in, please turn it in before New Business or you will have to wait until the next ASC meeting for the new motion to be read on the floor.

The GSR report is now just a half sheet for you to put your home group anniversaries. We were not using the top half and are trying to cut back on some costs. I accidentally sent out the old GSR report last month but will go back to the half page this month.

The cost of printing the minutes last month was \$133.90.

The GSR Orientation started today with 10 in attendance. I forgot to create a flyer. A flyer will go out in next month's minutes and copies will be here to take.

According to page 17 of our Policy under removal from the meeting schedule, "If there has not been a representative of the group present for four (4) consecutive ASCs, a group will be removed from the Tampa Funcoast Meeting Schedule. While a group is not required to be a voting member of ASC to be placed on the Tampa Funcoast Meeting Schedule, a representative (not necessary a GSR) must be present for ASC roll call. This ensures that meetings that no longer exist are not placed on the schedule"; therefore, the following groups have been removed from the meeting schedule, attendance and the mailing of minutes due to 4 or more absences: **No groups have been removed** "If a group has been removed from the Tampa Funcoast Meeting Schedule, it may be placed back on the list by sending a representative to ASC. At ASC, they should notify the Public Relations and Helpline Chairperson that they would like to be added to the next publication of the schedule."

According to page 17 of our Policy under becoming a voting group and scheduled meeting, "3. To maintain voting status, a group must not miss two consecutive ASC meetings. 4. The group will be removed from the mailing list after missing 2 consecutive ASC meetings. 5. To re-establish voting status, a GSR (or alternate) must attend two consecutive ASC meetings." **RCM Report:**

The Area Support Group is going over its allotted time for the 3<sup>rd</sup> RSC weekend in a row. Morning session will be from 8:30 AM on Saturday and end at 12:30. This morning session will include an orientation for new members coming to Fellowship Development.

H&I Resource Coordinator Report: There are **2 work groups that are inactive and need staffing** – Proposal to Enter Fox Hill Prison and Behind the Walls Sponsorship/The Bridge Project.

Discussed the BMLT (**B**asic **M**eeting **L**ist **T**oolbox) It is a complete NA meeting search and list system in one. It is a software program, called a "CMS" (**C**ontent **M**anagement **S**ystem), that is installed on our Web server. It creates an "instant" NA meeting list search engine, which includes maps, detailed listings, easy printing, and even direct Adobe PDF printable meeting lists. Daytona, Unity Springs and Bermuda Area have been added to BMLT. There are now 10 Areas in the Florida Region on BMLT.

RD/AD News: Living Clean The Journey Continues book due for release between Oct to Dec 2012. There is also a Traditions book that is on a two cycle plan so it won't be available until 2016

REPORT NOT SUBMITTED

**Public Relations:**

The Public Relations subcommittee met today at 1:00pm. There were 11 members present and 3 new members. We opened the meeting with the Serenity Prayer.

There were 1400 copies of the meeting schedules printed this month and there were 9 changes to the following meetings: Keep the Faith, Sunday Serenity, Radical Recovery, The Message, NAIL, How It Works, NA Speaker Meeting, and Sunset at Sunrise. In response to the closing of John Calvin Presbyterian Church and the unavailability of the Sonrise Worship Center, the normal process of updating the meeting schedule was

circumvented to provide members seeking meetings the most accurate information possible. GSR's remember to please submit a meeting change request form by the end of area to get your changes into the next schedule.

The Tampa Funcoast Website had **2891** unique visitors in **July**, which was an unexpected **increase** of **528** visitors from the month of **June**. Old Business:

In old business, 4 members from our area were in attendance for a poster hanging event in Plant City on July 28<sup>th</sup>. A special thanks to Liz G and Matt Y for giving us the suggestion and helping to make it happen.

Also, please remember our area-wide poster hanging event, happening next Saturday August 18<sup>th</sup> in South Tampa. Join us at the Starbucks on Gandy and Dale Mabry at 9am and help us spread our message broadly with the public at large.

We were able to place an 8-pocket literature rack at the Salvation Army Downtown and the Tampa Metro Methadone clinic and a selection of IPs at the Metro Wellness Center. We are also currently awaiting a response from a Department of Corrections regional supervisor in moving forward with getting our literature into probation offices across the Tampa Bay area.

Our last bit of old business was a planning meeting for a possible PR Learning Day, which happened on August 5<sup>th</sup>. We did make some decisions about the proposed event, but after hearing from other subcommittees to have a Unified Learning Day, we will put a hold on our planning and entertain the setup of an ad hoc committee meeting consisting of members from other subcommittees to plan the larger event.

New Business:

In new business, we were asked by the regional outreach chairperson for the Nar-Anon fellowship to provide representation an event called "A Day of Serenity", which is being held at DACCO on September 8<sup>th</sup> in recognition of National Recovery Month. We have 4 volunteers from Public Relations that will be at the event with Narcotics Anonymous literature on hand.

Our last item of new business included discussion of the BMLT (Basic Meeting Locator Toolbox), which is a system now being used in regions across the world and 6 areas in the Florida Region. This open-source application was created to standardize how meetings can be found with an interactive map interface. We are in favor of implementing this change to the Tampa Funcoast Website and it will be changed in the near future.
