Note: Area Minutes are also available for download on the Tampa Funcoast website. For all members of the ASC who give reports that are included in the ASC monthly minutes, I am requesting that you submit these reports typed. You can submit the report on the day of area service by memory stick, or you can email the report to me by the Wednesday following Area Service. All meeting changes (such as time or location) can be put in the GSR report box as well. GSR/Alt GSR **must** fill out a meeting schedule change form so that it can be updated on the meeting schedules and on our website. If you have a Motion Request form to turn in, it must be turned in before we discuss today's New Business or you will have to wait until the next ASC meeting for the new motion to be read on the floor.

\$144.12 was spent on printing and mailing of Area Minutes, Literature Order Forms and GSR Reports.

According to page 2 of our Policy (under *Removal From the Meeting Schedule*), "If there has not been a representative of the Group present for four (4) consecutive ASCs, a Group will be removed from the Tampa Funcoast Meeting Schedule. While a Group is not required to be a voting member of ASC to be placed on the Tampa Funcoast Meeting Schedule, a group representative must attend two consecutive ASC meetings", i.e., must be present for ASC roll call. This ensures that meetings that no longer exist are not placed on the schedule. Therefore, the following groups have been removed from the meeting schedule, attendance and the mailing of minutes due to four (4) or more absences: **Anda Group and New Tampa NA**. Per Policy (under *Reinstated to the Meeting Schedule*), "If a Group has been removed from the Tampa Funcoast Meeting Schedule, it may be placed back on the list by sending a representative to ASC. At ASC, they should notify the Public Relations and Helpline Chairperson that they would like to be added to the next publication of the schedule."

According to page 2 of our Policy (under *Becoming a Voting Group and Scheduled Meeting*): 3. "To maintain voting status, a Group must not miss two (2) consecutive ASC meetings. 4. As of October 1, 2014 we had 415 calls, using 1,249 minutes, and 6 messages for the preceding 30 days. Note that calls and minutes used from last month were up 25% in calls and 42% in minutes. Our average time on a call was at 3minutes/call. We are urging members to get involved as 12-step volunteer by letting me or any other Helpline member know. This is a critical issue as we only have 4 members serving in this role. We opened nominations for positions for next year. We formed an ad-hoc committee to review our guidelines and to make recommendations. Began preparations for Learning Day to be held on Saturday, October 18th at the Oak Grove Church of God at 6830 N Habana Avenue where we intend to provide a presentation that will include 12 Step volunteer training. Next subcommittee meeting will be Monday, November 3, 2014. In Loving Service, Aris R.

Hello Family, this is the short version of the final ASC Convention Report. We all are still recovering from the long weekend & still living our Lives. The FACNA XXX-Convention was a Big Success. We had 500 plus members there Saturday night, and well over 1000 years of Recovery, and that's Big. There were no major events, and a total of 8 area's, 6 states, and 1 other country attended. The Total cost paid to Embassy suites Hotel was \$13,056, The Total income from the actual Convention was over \$10,000.00. This Number was from Registrations, Merchandise, and outside Vendors. We had problems paying for everything up front before the Convention, and had to ask the ASC Body for help. They responded by paying off the debt of \$2800.00 the day of the Convention 10-3-14, and we raised \$6100 that same night, from Registrations & Merchandise. After the convention we return that \$2800 to the ASC account, paid off the Hotel, The RSO, and one of our Vendors. We are now waiting for all checks to clear, and we expect to return the seed money of \$2000.00 and plus additional funds of \$2800.00 roughly. Total of \$4800 the committee, also me personally; Want to thank the ASC Body for all the support, the Area for all the support. Lastly, but not lease. Thank You God for everything. It didn't have to be this way. There will be a final report made up for the ASC next month that will include a summary of all important information to view. Also to store on our website for future Convention Committees to have. And know what this committee did & How. ILS Steve C.

#### Results for September

During the month of Sept, income was \$3,601 and expenses were \$2,635 so we had net income of \$965. Our beginning balance was \$2,902 and our ending balance is now \$3,868.

#### Results for 2014 year to date

- Year to date income is \$34,920, expenses are \$31,709 and net income year to date is \$3,211 compared with a net income of \$752 for the first nine months of 2013.
- Expenses for nine months of \$31,709 compares with our total 12 month budget of \$65,094.
- All subcommittees are within their budgets for 2014.

#### Highlights

- Literature expense for September was \$1,747 compared to Literature income of \$2,017.
- One-time expense of \$300 for Learning Day food and supplies
- There was no RCM travel or Newsletter expense for September

**Clarify: only email minutes, not print**

Tradition 5: Each group has but one primary purpose-to carry the message to the addict who still suffers.

Concept 11: NA funds are to be used to further our primary purpose, and must be managed responsibly.

"When NA members contribute service funds, they expect their money to be used carefully, and to be used for the SOLE PURPOSE of furthering our primary purpose" (12 Concepts of NA, 14).

**Intent:** To end unnecessary spending on printing and mailing of ASC minutes with 7th Tradition funds.

**Action:** Voting in December.

Questions: Rich – what is the estimated amount saved by not printing the minutes? Kent - \$2,000. Fernando: what about GSRs that cannot afford email or to download the minutes? What if they can't afford the technology? Chelsie – would the maker be open to an Amendment? Alfred – how is their group going to exclude when everyone is supposed to “be a part of?” Answer – not about excluding, do we want to pay or not, make a decision. Valeria – how or for what reason do we need to change what has been working for 40+ years? Answer – Saving \$2,000 per year which is the same amount of seed money needed for convention. Chelsie – Would it change policy? Would it create disunity? Answer: It is up to the GSRs to vote. Stephen – suggestion: pass around the sign in sheet each month.
