Note: Area Minutes are also available for download on the Tampa Funcoast website. For all members of the ASC who give reports that are included in the ASC monthly minutes, I am requesting that you submit these reports typed. Located on the table to my right, are event flyers, literature order forms, GSR report forms, and meeting schedule change forms; as well as a box for all items to be submitted. All meeting changes (such as time or location) can be put in the GSR report box as well. GSR/Alt GSR **must** fill out a meeting schedule change form so that it can be updated on the meeting schedules and on our website. If you have a Motion Request form to turn in, it must be turned in before we discuss today's New Business or you will have to wait until the next ASC meeting for the new motion to be read on the floor.

\$76.50 was spent on printing Area Minutes and Literature Order Forms.

At today's GSR Orientation there was one in attendance. Please be sure to announce the GSR Orientation to all your groups.

According to page 1 of our Policy (under *Removal From the Meeting Schedule*), "If there has not been a representative of the Group present for four (4) consecutive ASCs, a Group will be removed from the Tampa Funcoast Meeting Schedule. While a Group is not required to be a voting member of ASC to be placed on the Tampa Funcoast Meeting Schedule, a group representative must attend two consecutive ASC meetings", i.e., must be present for ASC roll call. This ensures that meetings that no longer exist are not placed on the schedule. Therefore, the following groups have been removed from the meeting schedule, attendance and the mailing of minutes due to four (4) or more absences: **In The Middle**. Per Policy (under *Reinstated to the Meeting Schedule*), "If a Group has been removed from the Tampa Funcoast Meeting Schedule, it may be placed back on the list by sending a representative to ASC. At ASC, they should notify the Public Relations and Helpline Chairperson that they would like to be added to the next publication of the schedule."

According to page 1 of our Policy (under Becoming a Voting Group and Scheduled Meeting): 3. "To maintain voting status, a Group must not miss two (2) consecutive ASC meetings. 4. Florida Region did not donate to NAWS as there were expenses for the GSR Assembly.

Daytona Area currently has concerns about reaching the minority populations in their Area. If you have some experience and hope about how a predominantly white Area can make minorities feel more comfortable and included, please share with me so that I can pass ideas on to Daytona.

Nature Coast and River Coast are struggling and could use support. If you are planning some asphalt recovery and will be in Citrus or Hernando counties, please try to attend meetings in these areas.

Eight Regions applied for seating at the WSC in 2016. The workgroup for this has recommended the following 3 Regions for seating: Grande Sao Paulo, HOW, Rio de Janeiro. All 3 are from Brazil.

Fellowship contributions exceeded \$1 million in the last fiscal year, for the first time.

After WSC in April, information will be posted on the Regional website (from or RD/AD Team) as well as na.org. You can sign up for NAWS and WCNA updates (as well as other periodicals) sent to your email on na.org.

RD and AD attended the SEZF meeting in Atlanta. The CAR, CAT, and SEZF Guidelines were discussed. The Guidelines will be submitted for approval. All CAR motions are amendable on the floor; the RD/AD team was given the Region's vote of confidence if needed.

If anyone with a DOC number is being denied entry to a facility, please see Gilbert for assistance.

The positions of Regional PR Resource Coordinator, Alt Treasurer, RSO Board Member, and Archivist are open. See the website for qualifications and responsibilities. PLEASE, PLEASE ask those in your HG to consider one of these positions.

Several Workgroups still need staffing are listed in Regional Business. If you want to be a part of any of these, fill out the volunteer form on the Regional Website [<http://naflorida.org/service-list/>]. Be sure to include your non-NA skills as well as they may indicate your expertise in areas that may be important. You can click on the workgroup you wish to be involved with. WORKGROUP MEMBERS ARE REIMBURSED FOR MILEAGE COSTS TO RSC IF THEIR WORKGROUP HAS A DESIGNATED MEETING ON SATURDAY.

Region is creating a SPECIAL volunteer form specific to the next World Convention in 2018. Several *thousand* volunteers are needed. This should be available soon. Volunteers must be registered for the convention.

FRCNA: Rosen Shingle Creek in Orlando July 6 - 10. Planning meetings are the first Sunday of even numbered months. Pre-convention shirts and registration flyers are out. There are currently 219 registrations. Of the 350 available banquet tickets, 165 banquets have been sold, so if you are interested in going to the banquet be sure to buy your ticket or table soon. I have a volunteer sign-up list if you wish to sign up or you can also sign up to volunteer on-line. The FRC BOD is willing to lend their experience to local convention committees if needed.

The proposals for a Statewide Helpline and SEZF Guidelines did reach consensus.

The Regional Budget will be voted on in May. It is being amended and has not yet been provided. I will send it to the Secretary once I receive it so it can be included in the minutes. I will need your vote at the May ASC to take to the May RSC.
