RCM Report: RCM#1: Andy C.; RCM#2: Gilbert O.. The third weekend of March is the GSR Symposium in Tampa same place Sheraton East. *We have from a region for room nights that's two rooms for two nights male and female and they hope we put at least four people in each room. So, I need names of people who want to be on that list they would be responsible for checking in. It would be like Friday and Saturday night you can look up the dates I don't have a calendar in front of me but it's the third weekend of March. I will have to email our secretary with the information ASAP. But no later than the January RSC which will be the third weekend of January.* Also, region has set aside 1 car / area I will receive that if we want to order more they are \$7.50 each we can order them directly from world or from our RSO. Of course, we can also go online after November 29th and print them. But we should put it on our website so that groups can access that information and vote on the 27 proposals. I believe that's how many. I also need to let everybody know that that motion for us to direct region to direct world to do an accounting is incomplete. Number one it didn't quite follow the guidelines of a motion to region so I couldn't answer some of the questions. Like what is the financial impact What specifically do they want audited etc. Do they want to know every stamp plastic spoon napkin paper cup that was ever used by WSO or do they just want the main accounting things like okay it cost this much to send so-and-so to Japan to put on a workshop? Airfare was this hotel was this food expenses were this. They did not designate exactly what they want audited they just said everything and name different Departments of world. Financial impact would be okay if you expect them to do this what do you think it's going to cost NA to accomplish this. \$70,000 \$100,000 what would be the financial impact I turned it in as unknown. There is an audit in existence of the convention after the last World convention that's accessible online. There's been other financial report that can be requested from world or can be reviewed online. So, whoever made the proposal made it probably without even checking any of these things or researching when they were last performed. They're not objecting to the proposal because they already have a similar one in place and one of the proposals that we need to vote on in CAR is probably something similar and we won't know until we can review it November 29th. Also, I want everybody to know I have pre-convention t-shirts - I didn't get that many but they are to me on consignment. Next on the agenda would be a *feeling from the different groups for next area if we want to ask region to come and do a CAR workshop.* get together with another area and do a joint Workshop do we not want 1 at all.

So along with all the other things I said I want to add this, eventually it will be a report, there is an area that started doing their literature orders online the cutoff is a week before their area. Now you can still order at area but if you go online you can put in your literature order so that they are prepared. They say it's cut down on the inventory that they keep both in terms of dollars and Storage cuz they only order what they need period with some left over for the ones that order at area. Then you bring your written literature order with your funds and turn them in to the treasurer as always get a receipt and that enables you to pick it up but the orders are already ready. And they can be picked up when they pay because they're already prepared or they can still do what we do at the end of the meeting in another room you just go in and pick up your order. RESIGNATION OR IMPEACHMENT OF H&I SUBCOMMITTEE TRUSTED SERVANTS

The H&I Subcommittee Chairperson is an officer of the Tampa Funcoast ASC and resignation or impeachment of that office is covered in the Tampa Funcoast ASC Policy. For all other H&I Subcommittee trusted servant positions, the policy may be as follows:

Voluntary

Voluntary resignations are given in writing to the H&I Chairperson prior to an H&I Business Meeting.

Involuntary

Involuntary resignations are automatic upon the following:

1. Failing to maintain the required Business Meeting attendance to be considered a H&I member.
2. Relapse during term in office.

Impeachment Procedures

1. A motion to initiate impeachment procedures, is passed. A majority vote is required to initiate impeachment proceedings.
2. Individual will be given notice in writing at least seven days prior to the ASC meeting.
3. Present the motion of impeachment with said due cause.
4. The respondent is given time for a rebuttal, if so desired, not to exceed five minutes.
5. A closed ballot is taken.
6. A 2/3 vote of eligible voting member of the H&I subcommittee is necessary to impeach.

Elections

CONVENTION (OPEN) – Nominations being accepted. The qualifications for Convention Chair are: A minimum clean time requirement of three (3) years continuous abstinence from all drugs. Previous experience of at least six (6) months in serving the Public Relations Subcommittee; preferably as a member of the Administrative Committee. An understanding of the responsibilities of the office; administrative capabilities, and some knowledge in the field of Public Relations.

ASC CHAIRPERSON (CLOSED) – voting in December. The qualifications for ASC Chairperson:

Willingness and desire to serve. 2 years of continuous abstinence from all drugs. At least 1 year experience in the NA service structure. Time and resources to do the job. Ability to lead, communicate and organize.

***Nominee:** Mary S. Qualifications: Willingness and desire. Chair for the past year. I have the willingness and desire to serve. 9 years of continuous abstinence from all drugs. 5 years of experience in the NA service structure – 6 years as a HG Secretary, 2 years as a GSR, and 2 years as Alternate Secretary for ASC, 3 years as Secretary for ASC. Time and resources to do the job. Ability to lead, communicate and organize.*

ASC TREASURER (CLOSED) – voting in December. The qualifications of the ASC Treasurer: Time, willingness and desire to serve. At least 3 years of continuous abstinence from all drugs (cannot be waived). Active for at least one (1) year in the NA service structure. Basic knowledge of accounting procedures. Ability to lead, communicate and organize. Familiar with the ASC Policy, A Guide to Service in NA and the Twelve Traditions and Twelve Concepts.

***Nominee:** Terence B. Hello, my name is Terence B. and I'm 7 years clean, currently Treasurer, previously served as Alternate Treasurer, I've already had some service commitment at Area level.*

ASC ALTERNATE TREASURER (CLOSED) – voting in December. The qualifications for ASC Alternate Treasurer: The Alternate Treasurer works closely with the Treasurer, learning the duties of the office and taking over in case the Treasurer is unable to attend ASC. The requirements for the office of the Alternate Treasurer are the same as for the Treasurer. The Alternate Treasurer must attend ASC for 3 months of the last 12 months prior to nomination. Because the Alternate Treasurer might have to assume the position of the ASC Treasurer, the clean time requirement cannot be waived. The Alternate Treasurer is **not a co-signer on the ASC bank account.**

Nominee: Aida. *Qualifications: Hi family, I am an addict, my name is Aida W. I am in service, as your current Alternate Treasurer. I have been clean for 22 years. I have a sponsor, who has a sponsor. I have a working knowledge of the 12 steps, Traditions, and Concepts. I practice the spiritual principles in my life, to the best of my ability. I have held every position at my home group. I have been in service as: Registration Chair for the Women's Retreat (08), FRCNA Rep. for 2 years, H&I for 2 years. Helpline (2 yrs), I used to carry a beeper? I have the willingness, desire, and personal accounting experience necessary with skills to fill this position. In Loving Service, Aida W.*

ASC SECRETARY (CLOSED) - voting in December. The qualifications for ASC Secretary: Willingness and desire to serve. At least 1 year of continuous abstinence from all drugs. Active for at least 6 months in the NA Service Structure. Time and resources to do the job. Ability to lead, coordinate and organize.

Active for least 6 months in the NA service structure. Time and resources to do the job. Ability to lead, communicate and organize. Familiar with the Area Service Guidelines and Guide to Local Service.

Nominee: Sami. *Qualifications: 1 year clean, Chair at my homegroup, service work, stay late, come early, I have the willingness and organization skills. I have the time and resource to do this commit.*
