4. Policy Subcommittee found the motion to meet all requirements listed in policy (page 43, a,b,c and d) guidelines, a, b and c. However,in d, the POLICY SUBCOMMITTEE found the motion to be in conflict with our traditions, concepts and our Guide to Local Service. Rationale: In the 11th concept (the twelve concepts of NA service, pg 24, third paragraph, second sentence) it states “to fulfill our primary purpose, we need all of the financial resources at our fellowships disposal. In the fourth paragraph it goes on to state We practice concept 11 (paraphrase) “by establishing clear spending priorities and measuring each proposed expenditure against the priority list. Many groups, service boards and committees have more items on their priority list than their budgets will allow. In such cases, only the highest priorities can be funded. In the Guiding Principles,(pg 130, second sentence), it states” Our service bodies, however, are not autonomous and do not support themselves. In the Guide to local service on page 55 (it seems the only subcommittees that have the opportunity to bring funds to area are activities - including conventions and campouts) in the Activities section (second sentence), “activities like these can provide a greater sense of community for the local NA fellowship and produce additional area income. Finally, in looking at d in our policy guidelines, this motion would create many financial and accounting issues, since it not only allows a subcommittee to increase their budget without making a motion at the ASC, but it additionally, creates new accounting practices that do not exist in Narcotic Anonymous.
