RCM Report:

There is a LOT that happens during Regional Weekend. In my report, I only include things I think our Area will need to know or be interested in. The full RSC minutes can be viewed online at <https://naflorida.org/minutes/>. YOU can attend Region in person or via zoom at <https://naflorida.org/rsc/>.

Area Support and Fellowship Development issues discussed on Saturday:

1. Concern that YAP (the new helpline platform tied into the BMLT) is causing less human interaction with callers since it provides for automated responses. YAP is highly customizable and allows for varying degrees of automated and in-person interaction. We are one of only 4 Areas in the Region not using YAP. I have sent resources to the new Helpline Subcommittee Chair to explain the program so that our Helpline Subcommittee can make the decision about if this is a good move for us.
2. The 5 motions in the interim CAR and CAT (ICC) were discussed. The **CAR/CAT (ICC)** and draft of the **SPAD** are available online at <https://www.na.org/?ID=conference-index>.
 - a. Three of the motions in the CAR are procedural and are meant to postpone decisions that are supposed to be made this year but have been delayed until the full WSC in 2023 due to the pandemic.
 - b. Motion 4 is the approval of the SPAD
 - c. The one motion in the CAT is the World budget for 2022-2023
 - d. **There will be an ICC workshop on Feb 20th, 1p - 4p, at Terra Nova in Bay Area** where you can hear discussion about the motions and get your questions answered. The link to attend virtually is naflorida.org/car

The Admin performed the audit today and all records were and balanced and accurate. TUG and FNAMO need to register with world in order to vote on the CAR motions. We will be closing the Paypal account at the end of February as they are sending out 1099s for taxes if the incoming amount is over 600.00 a year. The Vice-Chair, Treasurer, and Secretary attended the Convention Committee meeting on the 24th to support the Convention and address some of the financial concerns. The Convention

Committee members in attendance answered all our questions and brought updated information to the meeting that was previously requested. More will be revealed in the Convention report. Secretary Report: Reading of Jan 2022 minutes. Minutes accepted

OPEN FORUM: Ramona apologized to the Committee, for the miscommunication, thinking that her absence had been excused. This was clarified that *if a committee person has 2 unexcused absences, they WILL be removed from their position.*

ASC Admin stated GSR's had questions about the Financials as well as was the Committee unified in putting on the convention. It was reported that the New Year's Eve dance produced \$1100.00, which was not true. ASC provided the form they use to track their Finances and ALL members were reminded this same form had been given out in November 2021 to use for reporting their funds. If a form is needed, see the Treasurer. The ASC Treasurer stated that we needed to show more accountability of the funds. FACNA owed ASC \$650 from funds that were used to secure the location for 2 events. **Motion made** that since Area is currently in the negative and FACNA has \$4612.94 in the bank, ASC is to remove those funds from our side of the account.

FACNA is to receive funds every other month from ASC stating this month Jan 2022, but there were no funds to give.

Vice Chair is very upset that the FACNA Chair has not been "doing his job" because he has not been in attendance since July. Regarding the impeachment; the GSR's voted 1 Abstain, 9 voted to not impeach and 4 voted to impeach. The vote did not meet quorum, so the Impeachment was tabled. FACNA Committee was reminded that the ASC votes the Convention chair, a member expressed this needs to be changed because when there is an issue at the Committee, our hands are tied to remove the person from this position.

REPORTS:

CHAIRPERSON – Smitty – contacted Bay Area about having a Speaker Jam, this was done previously, but no money was made. Chair stressed that the Bay Area does not have Convention, and this is a way to Unify both Areas. Chairperson submitted his resignation and resigned effective Jan 24, 2022. He does not want to be the source of discord.

VICE-CHAIRPERSON – Gary J. – discussed going to St Pete, he outlined his list of events that we should have for the next few months to raise funds. Several Speaker Jams, Talent Show, Fish Fry. VC stated he wants to get the GSR's involved to motivate home group members to support the events.

TREASURER – Mike W. – New Year's Eve event was successful, there was no cost to the Committee for Food & Beverages because it was donated by the Committee members. \$400

Security Deposit was returned to on 1/05/2022, but was not deposited into bank, because this same \$400 Deposit will be used again for the next event being held at this location. As of this meeting we currently have \$4612.94 in the bank for the FACNA Convention. Question was raised that during the Fundraiser in August 2021, Smitty stated he would purchase the Chicken for the event, but the credit card records show that he purchased the chicken using the card. Smitty put \$110.00 cash on the table. Mike has asked each Committee Chair that going forward they must fill out the Event Income Expense Form, which will reflect the funds coming and going out for the Committee. Report provided

SUBCOMMITTEE REPORTS:

ARTS & GRAPHICS – Chairperson – Taryn T. – Chair returned w/a new Logo for the Convention, it was accepted and voted on unanimously by the Committee. Taryn will go back and ask the Graphics person to put numbers on the measuring tape. Joel once he receives the Logo will ensure that FACNA 36 information is placed on t-shirts, mugs etc.

FUNDRAISING – Chairperson – Tony - We have several events: Valentines Dance Saturday Feb 12 – the Committee teamed up with the Women of Hope group who will provide Desserts for the V-Day Dance. Super Bowl Party Sunday Feb 13 (Flyers are available – both events.) \$200 was collected for food, sign-up sheets were passed around for who could do service and bring item to each event. Lori will inventory supplies, send to Secretary who will send out email of what additional items are needed for the 2 events. Future events: Saturday March 19 – Speaker Jam / Fish Fry / TBD (April or May) – Talent Show / looking at a Men's Unity, Women's Unity Day, Taste of NA, Karaoke

HOTEL & HOSPITALITY – Tina J. – Currently have 10 reservations, we must purchase Insurance for the Convention weekend, motion made & accepted for \$2 million policy at cost of \$187.00 to FACNA. The concern was raised that the Committee is giving away too much food, and Committee was reminded that we have a \$10,000 Food & Beverage Budget that must be met. These concerns will be addressed later.

INFORMATION – Ramona C. – Chair received & faxed over the Convention flyers to 5 rehabs. Asking that if anyone knows of any other Treatment Facilities, Halfway, Transitional Houses to please provide her with this information, so we can keep them aware of events and convention.

MERCHANDISE – Chairperson – Joel B. – Currently have 42 shirts on hand, \$100 cash was turned in. Chair will not be town weekend Feb 12 (Taryn will handle Merchandise) and Sunday Feb 13 (Tracy said she would handle Merchandise). Provided information about cost of

cups, and the Vendor is the same Vendor that FRCNA uses, so we are getting a deal on the Merchandise as well as free shipping.

PROGRAMMING – Chairperson – Lori M. – this Committee meets the 1st 7 3rd Monday of each month, have a few more acts to review as far as the DJ, Comedienne and Live Entertainment. They are waiting to receive additional information concerning Recordings. A motion was made to request 6 Registrations at the price of \$25, but there were not enough Committee members remaining to vote.

REGISTRATION – Chairperson – Elvin S. – sold 5 online, will work out a system with the Treasurer to ensure that the Square App registration funds are accounted for. The most current Convention Flyer is up to date. This Committee meets the 3rd Thursday of each month via Zoom, or phone.

I am Frank and I am an addict.

We had an HnI panel leader who text me about something he had a concern with. He works at the facility where he brings a HnI panel into for many months now. Further he was elected coordinator for this facility and another panel at just another location last month.

He only told me because he received a promotion and will be working directly with addict clients now. I had no idea he worked at the facility.

How can we state we are not affiliated with the facility we bring a HnI presentation in representing NA yet are employed by the Facility?

I know he meant no harm and that's why he reached out to me. He mentioned Craig M. knew he worked for the facility. The facility had no issues with him still carrying the presentation but he felt it might not be appropriate now he is on the client side.

After reaching out to plenty of experienced NA members. I told him this individual it's a goodtime to explain NA traditions and why he no longer can participate in a HnI meeting where he works at our next presentation there. I did suggest that he step down from the panel due to these new circumstances.

The individual totally understood and I assured him he still can carry the NA message to addict clients, just outside of a NA HnI presentation at the facility he works at.

The Funcoast RCM reached out to me this past month. In our region she informed me that the Southeast Zonal Forum has an H&I Task Force to assist H&I meetings to re-enter facilities post-COVID closure. While a great resource we managed several transitions at the Funcoast HnI subcommittee with not one issue. We did discuss this resource in the meeting however today.

White sands plant city presentation as of: Jan. 26th per the facility requested is moving the panel to Wednesday nights from Friday. We had no issues with that.

We carried 68 Of 70 HnI presentations missing two due to the required two members need to have a HnI presentation.
