● Do any HGs / Areas do an annual inventory?

● A concern was brought up about IP8 - a sentence reads “God has forgiven us for our past mistakes.” The concern is that it is too religious. World Board was contacted about the concern. ● Discussion about collaboration among US Zones

○ 8 US Zones currently (groups of Regions), 15 worldwide.

○ This collaborative is an attempt to become a central hub to collect service requests and act as a portal to communicate with the associated local community.

○ Collaboration ideas include

■ Planning first / create strategic plan

■ Public relations / Fellowship development tools

■ US Website (including meeting information)

○ Asking for the conscience of the Region to create a US Centralized Zone made up of all US Zonal forums for service-oriented tasks as a central hub. Not another level of service, just a collaboration. Does the Area approve/disapprove/ need more info?.

Collaboration of US zones will strive to:

■ Raise awareness of the zones in the US as positive, reliable, and valuable assets in achieving our primary purpose.

■ Provide a national resource that brings consistency and accessibility to communications within the fellowship and with the public in the US.

■ Provide internal services and training to US Zones and local NA communities in public relations, fellowship development, technology, and communications.

■ Be strategic in its planning and offer project-based resources when requested.

■ Energize and stimulate the growth of NA in the United States by enhancing cooperation, coordination, and information sharing.

○ It was expressed that this could add another level between groups and NAWS. Seems that all that is being discussed could be part of the NAWS website.

I like to thank everyone in the subcommittee for their service work this past month.

Richard from PR asked me if our panel members could give out our Funcoast NA business cards with help line number and scan code to participants at our presentations. I seen nothing wrong with this and we could add the cards with our literature we pass out at panels. There was no objections from the committee.

This past month Debbie reached out to me from the Thonassassa Youth Facility wanting to resume our HnI panel there.

The panel was suspended due to the pandemic and was held Wednesdays at 630pm. This is a very difficult panel because the clients are juveniles and there are additional guidelines we follow bringing in a presentation. She did not mention a vaccine status or criminal background as in the past however to participate. The county Jails are ready also to resume presentations.

We should know more next month and get started on getting recovering addicts cleared to participate.

Hopefully we can support these meetings, but I have my doubts due to lack of participation over the years from the funcoast area on the HnI subcommittee.

We are very short handed and 3 of our panels have only one HnI member relying on an outside speaker to carry the meeting each week.

Anyone interested in joining HnI we surely could use the support. Currently we have 5 panels needed by facilities we can not carry due to lack of willing recovering addicts to give back to newcomers.

My personal willingness to give back thru HnI has been very rewarding for all of my years in recovery. Witnessing an addict in a facility at a HnI meeting and watching them stick around go to meetings and working a Narcotics Anonymous program is priceless. It reinforces why we give back thru HnI. The only way to experience this is to get involved with HnI

Last months make up meeting we had 3 new attendees in person. Today we met here at 12 noon and had approximately 15 members present and 1 new attendee.

We carried all panels with the exemption of 2 presentations due to our inability to have enough support.

.We also have no support to carry the five more presentations needed currently.

We meet next month here before area at 12 noon and the Thursday After area at St Pauls lutheran church at 7pm.
