## **Open Floor:**

I'm an addict named Jeremy. I would like to address a personal grievance I have with today's policy subcommittee meeting. I would first like to read concept 10, and the first paragraph, taken from the 12 concepts I.P.

"Any member of a service body can petition that body for the redress of a personal grievance, without fear of reprisal. The tenth concept is our fellowship's guarantee of respect for the individual trusted servant. This concept may seem self-evident, but our belief in the principle involved is so strong that we want to say it loudly and clearly. Narcotics Anonymous is a spiritual society, with high ideals for how we treat each other. Our members, however, are only human, and we sometimes mistreat one another. The tenth concept is our spiritual society's promise that if one of us is wronged in the service environment, the aggrieved trusted servant may ask that the wrong may be made right."

I would also like to point out concept nine before I get into the details. "All elements of our service structure have the responsibility to carefully consider all viewpoints in their decision-making processes."

Today, we were reviewing the policy subcommittee guidelines, and making changes we determined should be made. Several times during the course of this meeting, people were talking over one another; the floor was not being respected, and business could not be conducted properly. There were a couple times I would raise my hand to speak on a topic and would get rude comments made because I wanted to speak. I could not even speak on some points because I was being interrupted by other members. I had hit my limit of being disrespected, so I spoke out against it. A heated argument broke out briefly; I felt threatened, because one member asked me if I wanted to "take it outside."

I would like to formally apologize to that committee for my part in this. I would also like to formally resign as vice chair of the policy subcommittee. It has been a pleasure serving the needs of this area.

We met at Club Yana on Monday 6/5 at 7pm. There were 10 members in attendance. There were 150 calls received for a total of 164 minutes and all calls were answered. All shifts are currently being covered on a weekly rotation. Our next meeting is on 7/10 at 7pm at Club Yana. Over the past 3 months the subcommittee has discussed the YAP program that is being used by other areas. Multiple members have tried to utilize the system and we have decided as a committee that we are currently unwilling to change to that system. I would be happy to address the issues that our members had with the program during my report if the area has specific questions.

## **Hospitals & Institutions:**

We met today at noon with approximately 25 in attendance. We had one new attendee and four returning for their second business meeting. We carried 23 out of 28 presentations last month. We missed two presentations because of last-minute sickness and the other three because of facility problems. We have two males with their PV numbers for the jails and three females. We have one woman performing her training today that will make four females ready. One male is waiting on his application to be approved. The jails require 4 or 5 persons per sex to be able to start bringing in meetings. We are getting close but still need people willing and able to go into the jail. All other current facilities have at least three members, we would like to carry a presentation into Turning Point next and add one to Acts detox on Sundays. Jill D has stepped up and was voted in as Vice-chair. Please thank her for her service. We have voted to disband the make-up meeting. We had only one attendee in the last six months. We can always restart if we see the need.
