- FRSC did not meet in October.
- The next FRSC will be held on November 17-19, 2023 in Orlando.
- Planning for the "2024 Women in Service Dinner" will start on that Saturday after the Guide Meeting. All are welcome. The Women in Service Dinner will take place during the Florida Service Symposium, on the third weekend in March 2024.
- At the next FRSC, Fellowship Development will be workshopping the IDT on "Dealing with Disruptive and Predatory Behavior." All NA members can participate and have a voice in this process. We encourage all NA members to attend both the Regional Service Weekend and the Florida Service Symposium.
- The four proposals that were tabled at the last FRSC will be discussed next weekend. We are asking for the Group Conscience of this body on how to proceed. **Option for us** to ask that the proposals be tabled back to the Groups to decide. Straw poll: Yes.
- There were some questions asked by the GSRs during the October ASC. We have reached out to get the answers to those questions and here is what we have:

Q: Access to HRP information right now:

- This question was in reference to a letter submitted by the previous HRP leader stating they would not be seeking reelection.
- The answer we received via phone call was that the HRP leader is selected internally among HRP panel members and those members have selected Jennifer to lead. The HRP leader is the only panel member that has access to HRP sensitive information.

Q: The new conference cycle and an Interim GSR Assembly:

- There are no definitive plans at this time for an Interim GSR Assembly and there is no budget line item for one.
- If it is the conscience of this body, we can bring that question to Area Support and/or Fellowship Development at the next FRSC weekend.

September 2023 Treasurer Report

On July 1, 2023, the combined opening bank balance was \$45,208.40. Deposits of \$28,526.62 and expenses of \$(13,038.98) left an ending bank balance of \$60,696.04 on August 31, 2023.

\$10,000.00 GSR Assembly Reserve

As of FRSC held on September 17, 2023, we received \$400.00 in contributions and \$6,375.28 in expenses.

At the close of FRSC business (Sept.), the available balance was (\$7,354.24).

Tampa Funcoast ASC - Ad hoc Subcommittee

Purpose: To discuss the benefit of organizing the Area as a non-profit organization.

A non-profit organization is a group organized for purposes other than generating profit and in which no part of the organization's income is distributed to its members, directors, or officers.

Non-Profits are issued a Tax ID number and are tax exempt under Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3). Tax exempt status applies to both federal income taxes and state sales taxes.

Pros: Ability to do business such as: open new bank accounts, enter into contracts, purchase insurance and other regular business-related transactions. (all require a Federal Tax ID number)

Eliminate the need for individual members to personally assume the legal and financial liability of the Tampa Funcoast. Examples: Hotel Contracts, storage units and other rental spaces. See Florida Statute 617 – Officers and Directors of certain corporations and associations not for profit, immunity from civil liability. (attached)

Eliminate the sales taxes incurred on the purchase of literature, hotel rooms, and other supplies. See Cost Benefit below.

Title XXXVI Chapter 617 View Entire Chapter
BUSINESS ORGANIZATIONS CORPORATIONS NOT FOR PROFIT

617.0834 Officers and directors of certain corporations and associations not for profit; immunity from civil liability.—

- (1) An officer or director of a nonprofit organization recognized under s. 501(c)(3) or s. 501(c)(4) or s. 501(c)(6) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or of an agricultural or a horticultural organization recognized under s. 501(c)(5), of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, is not personally liable for monetary damages to any person for any statement, vote, decision, or failure to take an action, regarding organizational management or policy by an officer or director, unless:
 - (a) The officer or director breached or failed to perform his or her duties as an officer or director; and
 - (b) The officer's or director's breach of, or failure to perform, his or her duties constitutes:
- 1. A violation of the criminal law, unless the officer or director had reasonable cause to believe his or her conduct was lawful or had no reasonable cause to believe his or her conduct was unlawful. A judgment or other final adjudication against an officer or director in any criminal proceeding for violation of the criminal law estops that officer or director from contesting the fact that his or her breach, or failure to perform, constitutes a violation of the criminal law, but does not estop the officer or director from establishing that he or she had reasonable cause to believe that his or her conduct was lawful or had no reasonable cause to believe that his or her conduct was unlawful;
- 2. A transaction from which the officer or director derived an improper personal benefit, directly or indirectly; or
- 3. Recklessness or an act or omission that was committed in bad faith or with malicious purpose or in a manner exhibiting wanton and willful disregard of human rights, safety, or property.
 - (2) For the purposes of this section, the term:
 - (a) "Recklessness" means the acting, or omission to act, in conscious disregard of a risk:
- 1. Known, or so obvious that it should have been known, to the officer or director; and
- 2. Known to the officer or director, or so obvious that it should have been known, to be so great as to make it highly probable that harm would follow from such action or omission.
- (b) "Director" means a person who serves as a director, trustee, or member of the governing board of an organization.
- (c) "Officer" means a person who serves as an officer without compensation except reimbursement for actual expenses incurred or to be incurred.

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ADDENDUM "A" (BYLAWS)

of BASCNA, INC. (Adopted September 12, 2011)

> ARTICLE I NAME

Section 1.01. The exact name of the Corporation is Florida Regional Service Office, Inc. d/b/a BASCNA, Inc.

ARTICLE II ORGANIZATIONAL PURPOSE

Section 2.01: Organization. The BASCNA, INC. was organized on August 31, 2011 as a Florida Not For Profit Corporation.

Section 2.02: Purpose. The Corporation is organized to coordinate the efforts of Narcotics Anonymous Groups in the Bay Area in carrying the message of Narcotics Anonymous. The BASCNA, INC. will carry the message of Narcotics Anonymous by providing community public information services, telephone contact lines, various educational events and panel presentations to addicts in treatment centers and jails.

To conduct such other activities and programs in furtherance of the foregoing purposes as may be carried out by a Corporation organized under Florida General Laws Chapter 617 and described in §501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Section 2.03: Limitations on Activities. Consistent with its charitable and educational status, (a) BASCNA, INC. shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office; (b) no part of BASCNA, INC.'s net earnings shall inure to the benefit of officers, Directors or other private persons, except that it is authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and otherwise to make payments and distributions in furtherance of its charitable and educational purposes; and (c) BASCNA, INC., shall take only actions permitted by an organization exempt from taxation under §501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 ("the code") and pertinent Income Tax Regulations, as amended and as they may be amended.

ARTICLE III MEMBERSHIP

<u>Section 3.01: Voting Members</u>. BASCNA, INC.'s voting membership shall be all current groups in Bay Area of Narcotics Anonymous that are organized and operated exclusively for §501(c) (3) purposes. Membership in BASCNA, INC. is at will.

Section 3.02: Membership Meetings.

- a) Annual Meeting. There will be at least one membership meeting held annually in the month of September on the second Sunday.
- b) Special Meetings. Additional membership meetings may be called by a simple majority of the members. A request for a special meeting shall be made at the monthly Bay Area Service Committee Meeting and the special meeting shall take place within 45 days of the request.
- c) Quorum. A quorum for a membership meeting shall be a simple majority.
- d) Actions. The voting membership, acting pursuant to these bylaws, shall elect and may remove

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
